

Bedrock Earthscapes - 4/19/2024 Maintenance Report

We made our first maintenance visit to Fox Creek on Friday. All four basins were spot treated for broadleaf weeds and reed canary grass, as well as cool season grasses in the natives. The woody cutting and burns looked good around all basins.

- Blue Lake Pond has a nice stand of natives all the way around the pond. The south end has a bad infestation of Canadian Thistle that will take several seasons to eliminate or control.**
- Baseball Pond looks great with the woodies removed. Cut stumps have not yet resprouted in any of the areas. There was a good bit of Reed canary grass along the water edge of this basin.**
- Fox Creek Pond has a weak stand of natives and a lot of Reed canary Grass on the south and east banks. Some branches from woody cutting were left at the NW end or someone since dumped them there.**
- JJ/West Pond is in very poor condition with weed growth covering most of the banks. Reed Canary grass in the water near the banks was treated as were heavy weed issues all the way around. The south bank was heavy with wild parsnip and reed canary grass. Some wild roses are also on the banks.**
